


PS 1 – Weather

They will open it up to see what their spilt milk looks like.</p> <p>Wednesday: Fun with a Parent - Painting flower pots!</p> <p>Thursday: Rainbow umbrellas -Using coffee filters children will color with markers then spray them with water to create rainbow umbrellas.</p> <p>Friday: Cloud painting - Children will use puffy paint to create clouds.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Water</p> <p>In the water table children will be able to create a rainy day duck parade using ducks and rain maker buckets!</p> <p style="text-align: center;"></p>
